



Construction & General Industry 10 Hour & 30 Hour Training Classes

10 Hour Construction

Includes mandatory instruction on OSHA Scope & Purpose, Occupational Health & Environmental Controls, Company specific safety and health program review, Fall Protection, Electrical, and may include site specific training in: cranes & rigging, PPE, Health Hazards in construction, Materials Handling, Hand & Power Tools, Scaffolds, Excavations, and Stairways & Ladders.

30 Hour Construction

The 30 Hour class includes mandatory instruction on OSHA Scope & Purpose, Occupational Health & Environmental Controls, Company specific safety and health program review—with additional time requirements for mandatory training, and allows for additional time for a more thorough review of Fall Protection, Electrical, site specific electives and additional topics as time allows, including cranes & rigging, PPE, Health Hazards in construction, Materials Handling, Hand & Power Tools, Scaffolds, Excavations, and Stairways & Ladders. Classes are tailored to your training needs.

10 Hour General Industry

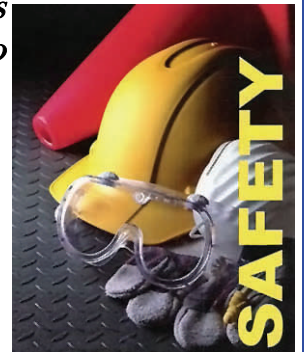
Includes required instruction on the OSH Act, General Duty Clause, Employer/Employee Rights & Responsibilities, Safety & Health Programs, and includes a few select topics, specific to the individuals being trained. Topics are outlined in the 30 Hour description below.

30 Hour General Industry

The 30 Hour training provides additional training and information included in the mandatory section of the 10 hour class, with additional time requirements for more intensive site-specific subjects. Classes may be tailored to include a number of the topics available. This class can be designed around each company's area of industry and can be site/employee specific, including: Walking/Working Surfaces, Exit Routes, Emergency Action Plans, Fire Prevention, Electrical, PPE, Materials Handling, Hazard Communication, Hazardous Materials, Machine Guarding, Welding, Cutting, and Brazing, Introduction to Industrial Hygiene, Blood borne Pathogens, Ergonomics, Safety and Health Programs, and Fall Protection.
