Does Your Facility Use or Store Chemicals?

The Chemical Facility Anti-Terrorism Standard (CFATS) regulates companies that store chemicals above established thresholds. The Dept. of Homeland Security is responsible for administering the program.

- Companies covered under the standard are required to complete the following:
 - Security Vulnerability Assessment (SVA)
 - Site Security Plan (SSP)

Lead Abatement
